

I-405, Brickyard to SR 527 Improvement Project

The Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) is beginning the Design-Build contract procurement process for the I-405, Brickyard to SR 527 Improvement Project. WSDOT will hold an informational meeting for interested contractors and consultants regarding the Request for Qualifications (RFQ) on Thursday, June 9, 2022.

The I-405, Brickyard to SR 527 Improvement Project will create a dual express toll lane (ETL) system from south of the I-405/SR 522 interchange to the I-405/SR 527 interchange. This project includes new lanes, direct access ramps, interchange improvements, Stride bus rapid transit stations and related facilities, and new fish passage culverts within the project vicinity.

Major scopes of work include:

- Bridge demolition, construction and retrofit
- Mass excavation, paving, and hauling
- Retaining and noise wall construction
- Stormwater infrastructure construction
- Fish barrier corrections and stream restoration
- Transit facilities including elevators and comfort station
- Toll Infrastructure, ITS, illumination, and overhead signs
- Pavement marking
- Maintenance of traffic

Inclusion goals for the Project are set in the amounts of:

- **Voluntary goals:** 10% Minority / 6% Women
- **Enforceable goals:** 5% Small / 3% Veteran

The purpose of this information meeting is to discuss the scopes of work in detail, potential opportunities for work, the Design Build procurement process, schedule and next steps. We will also provide time for questions and answers.
